REMINDER - Apply for Free Home Energy Upgrades

Apply for a Home Upgrade Grant as soon as possible so that your home can be made warmer in time for next winter!

To be eligible for an energy efficiency grant, you must:

- Not use gas to heat your home
- Have a household income of under £36,000 a year, regardless of any savings
- Have an EPC for your home of D, E, F or G (if you don't have a current EPC this can be arranged for free)
